Thank you for your request for information which we received on 14 March 2022.

I am pleased to confirm the following.

Please provide details of the type (manufacturer and model), quantity, department, site where they are located, and age of all Blood Gas Analysers listed on your trust's asset register (or equivalent).

We have 14 blood gas analysers in total in the hospital. They are all Radiometer ABL90 Flex + models. Two of these were purchased in October 2018, one purchased in April 20. The remaining 11 are on a contract with Radiometer, these were installed between June & November 2021.

These analysers are located in the following departments.

A&E 3 analysers, 2 purchased by ED 1 from contract

DoCC 1 analyser purchased April 20

Biochemistry; MAU; NNU; Labour Ward; PAU; Ward 15; Phase 1 theatre; Phase 2 theatre; Resp Med & Point of care.

1 analyser in each of these locations provided as part of contract, installed between June & November 21.
