



Request under Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your letter which we received on 26 September 2019.

I regret to inform you that we are unable to provide the information you requested.

This request is exempt under Section 36(3) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. Section 36(3) of the Act provides that there is no duty to confirm or deny whether we hold the information. We are not obliged to confirm or deny whether we hold the information you have requested as this would prejudice or be likely to prejudice the effective conduct of public affairs.

Milton Keynes University Hospital NHS Foundation Trust together with partners in the Thames Valley Local Resilience Forum holds information on a wide range of subjects to enable contingency planning. This information includes considerations relating to the UK exit from the European Union. However I can neither confirm nor deny whether we hold the specific information that you have requested.
