	We are unable to provide the number of bookings that are made per month. Patients use the e- Referral system to book appointments and the date they book their appointment is not stored in any of the Trust information systems (data warehouse), hence we are unable to answer this question.	
How many appointment cancellations are processed - per month and year?	Provided is the average hospital cancellation rate of all first outpatient appointments received via the e-Referral system for the last twelve months. Please note that the majority of these cancelled appointments will have been rescheduled. Considering that some of these bookings are made by patients up to six months in advance using the e-Referral system, invariably a proportion of those bookings are rescheduled due to annual leave, sickness of clinicians and other unforeseen circumstances.	22.3%
