In terms of qualifications i.e. Counselling the Trust has a prenatal screening team that have undertaken study sessions on how to give screening results and how to offer follow on care plans.

These include: midwifery training and preceptor qualification, Antenatal Results and Choices 3-day study course, Genetic Risk Assessment and Counselling, Kings college London course.
