I am pleased to confirm the following.

## 1. What services are provided by your hospital for patients with Dravet syndrome?

- Treatment initiation Yes
- Titration of dose (consider both starting and maintenance treatment) Yes
- Monitoring (incl. echocardiographies, liver function tests, etc.) As needed
- Review of clinical presentations (frequency, duration) Yes
- On-going prescription of treatments Yes
- Completing the Blueteq forms Not at MKUH; But done by tertiary centres by Paediatric Neurologists (at Oxford/GOSH) as clinically indicated
- **Other** .... General Paediatrics, Physiotherapy, Orthoptics, Orthopaedics, Community paediatric and nursing support as needed.
