I am pleased to confirm the following.

Can you confirm your Trust has adopted the Fatigue and Facilities Charter? And can you confirm that you have a nominated employer representative for dealing with fatigue and facilities?

The Trust has agreed with the Charter in principle. There is not a nominated employer representative, however, the Trust is working in partnership with the BMA, the Joint Local Negotiating Committee (JLNC) and the local Junior Doctors Forum towards its implementation. The Medical Director and Director of Workforce both attend the JLNC.
