Thank you for your request for information which we received on 04 October 2019.

I am pleased to confirm the following.

1) Please could you give me a final figure on the number of staff involved with direct patient care who were NOT vaccinated? **908**

2) Could you break this figure down by the number NOT vaccinated who were employed as (a) doctors, (b) nurses, (c) other professionally qualified clinical staff and (d) support staff. **a-200, b-311, c-46, d-351**

3) In relation to these staff who were NOT vaccinated how many in each of those four groups were taken away from working in a position where they had direct patient care because they did not have the vaccination? **No staff were taken away from the working area.**
