I am analysing the usage of intra-vitreal injections or implants by the NHS. Could you please tell me how many of the following intra-vitreal injections/implants your trust has administered in the four-month period from January to April 2024:

•	Aflibercept	1,141 injections
•	Bevacizumab – Avastin	159 injections
•	Bevacizumab – Biosimilar	0 injections
•	Brolucizumab	57 injections
•	Dexamethasone	1 implant
•	Faricimab	0 injections
•	Fluocinolone acetonide	0 implants
•	Ranibizumab - Lucentis (pre-filled syringes)	44 injections
•	Ranibizumab - Lucentis (vials)	0 injections
•	Ranibizumab – Ongavia	0 injections
