1. Please can you confirm the emergency departments (ED) within your trust - both their name and address.

2. In each of your EDs are your registered nurses (RN) allowed to give intravenous (IV) morphine.

5. If RNs are allowed to give either IV Morphine, IV Diamorphine or IV Fentanyl - did they undertake a specific drug training package?

RNS attend IV medication training. They work within their scope of practice. They all complete mandatory medicine management training. There is also an Acute pain study day.

Morphine is our first line analgesic for the Trust, we rarely give diamorphine or fentanyl.
