Thank you for your request for information which we received on 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2023.

I am pleased to confirm the following.

**Are Junior Doctors being paid for days they've been on strike/will be on strike? By "junior doctors" we mean anyone with the title: FY1/ FY2/ ST/ SpR/GPST or anyone else you include in that category.**

Junior Doctors are not paid when they are on strike.

**How much has been/will be paid in total to junior doctors for days on which they have been on strike? Costs can be grouped or split out into different types of "junior doctor".**

Junior Doctors are not paid when they are on strike.

**Please send any correspondence relating to any decisions on whether to pay junior doctors for days on which they are striking.**

This question is exempt under Section 40 – Personal Information this would involve looking at the personal records of staff members.

**How many junior doctors do you have and what proportion are they of workforce?**
