## Request under Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your request for information which we received on 25 November 2019.

I am pleased to confirm the following.

- 1. The number of working days lost to stress, anxiety, depression and other mental health conditions by members of staff within the your trust, by year since 2009.
- 2. The cost of losing these working days (based on wage multiplied by working hours lost)

Please note that we have given the days lost as calendar days lost because we do not record working days in ESR. We do not have any data before 2013 because we only started recording absence reasons in 2013.
