



Request under Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your request for information which we received on 24 April 2020.

I am pleased to confirm the following.

1. The average amount of overtime pay earned in March 2020 in pounds and pence by NHS consultants in each of the following groups:

- a) 2003 (2004 contract for employers in Scotland) contract consultant with 7 years' service completed Please see below.
- b) 2003 (2004 contract for employers in Scotland) contract consultant with 15 years' service completed Please see below.
- c) Pre-2003 (pre-2004 for employers in Scotland) contract level 4 consultant
