Thank you for your request for information which we received on 26 September 2022.

I am pleased to confirm the following.

1.How many incidents of racial abuse BY PATIENTS towards NHS staff (physical, verbal or written), were reported by NHS staff between 01.01.2019 – 31.12.2019?

There were 21 incidents recorded on DATIX under the heading of racial abuse by patients towards staff
