The Trust records 'Death in Service' only for the purposes of its Electronic Service Record

3) Please include copies of any 'death in service' procedure or policy the organisation uses.

The Trust uses the NHS Pension Scheme death in service procedure which is freely available on the NHS Business Services Authority website

4) Please describe if there is any work in progress to address mental health needs or suicide risk among your nursing workforce, or alternatively where there have been suicides whether there have been any changes in workplace practices as a result?

The Trust Board has been trained in the accredited Mental Health First Aid programme; this is now being rolled out across the Trust. The Trust has also recently outlined its mental health support by promoting its various support avenues for World Mental Health Day (attached) and has completed a series of Suicide Awareness workshops. The Trust has also recently revised its Rooftop Incidents policy to take account of colleagues and service users with mental health conditions and at risk of suicide.

The Trust also has an active Peer 2 Peer staff support scheme.

As a teaching hospital, we conduct education and research to improve healthcare for our patients. During your visit students may be involved in your care, or you may be asked to participate in a clinical trial. Please speak to your doctor or nurse if you have any concerns.
