Thank you for your request for information which we received on 11 February 2021.

I am pleased to confirm the following.

- 1. Who is the individual the Trust reports to on RTT performance at STP/ICS level? Milton Keynes University Hospital is part of the Bedford, Luton and Milton Keynes ICS. There is no requirement to report RTT performance to the ICS as the data is recorded on National systems.
- 2. What is your budget allocation for RTT/patient pathway validation? The Trust does not have a specific budget for RTT validation.
- Is the Trust using or considering external support for RTT/patient pathway validation and/or data quality improvement? The Trust is not currently using external validators.
- 4. Who is the budget holder for RTT/patient pathway validation at the Trust? The Head of Patient Access is the budget holder for the management of RTT.
