However we have provided you the number of patients that were admitted to the hospital and had one of the diagnosis codes coded to the inpatient spell as sickle cell condition. We have also provided the number of admissions (one patient may be admitted more than once in the above time frame) with sickle cell condition during the above mentioned date range.   This does not imply that the patients were treated for this condition.   Also please note that patients with sickle cell condition can also be treated in an outpatient setting. Outpatient data available in the data warehouse does not contain patient diagnosis. Hence we are not able to provide any outpatient treatment figures.
