9-10am - One to one 10-11am - Paired PR 13:00-14:00pm - One to one 15:00 - 16:00pm - Paired PR

Tuesday

10:00 - 11:00am - Paired PR

Wednesday

9am - One to one 10am - One to one 13:15 - 15:15 pm - PR group (8 patients)

Thursday

14:30 - 15:30pm - Paired PR 15:30 - 16:30pm - Paired PR

Altogether the number of patients currently 22
