Thank you for your request for information which we received on 20 December 2021.

I am pleased to confirm the following.

- 1. How many patients in the last 2 years attended A&E and were discharged (non-admitted) with a diagnosis of UTI? 1.238 Patients
- 2. How many patients were still admitted regardless of diagnosis of UTI? 1,160 Patients
- 3. How many of the patients attending A&E with diagnosis of UTI were women over the age of 65?
