Milton Keynes University Hospital runs a weight loss programme facilitated by a third party - More Life. I would like to know the following information about the course :-How many people have been referred or self referred to this programme in the last 24 months? What is the percentage of Male and Female participants? What age ranges are the participants i.e 20's, 30's, 40's, 50's and 60's or over? How many people complete the course? By gender and age bracket What is the average length of time people stay with course if not the full 12 weeks? By gender and age braker What is the average weight loss? By gender and age bracket What is the average cost of the course per person? Is the course paid for on completion of the course or at commencement? What is the contact length for the supplier? When did the supplier first begin running the course for MKUH?
