Thank you for your request for information which we received on 12 October 2018.

I am pleased to confirm the following.

Please inform me as to how many nurses work throughout the whole of Milton Keynes Hospital at one time, and how many nurses are required to be on a ward at a time.

Please see attached.

The Trust currently has 1004 Registered Nurses and Midwives in the hospital. All the wards have different staffing requirements due to bed numbers and Acuity but a standard ward works on 4 Registered nurses and 3 Health Care Assistants to 28 beds.

Additionally, I would like to know how many patients are currently staying overnight on a ward at Milton Keynes Hospital.

Occupancy varies from ward to ward but on average the Trust is running at 96%.
