<b>1. How many patients in the last 5 years up to April 2019 with the Sickle cell condition have been treated at Milton Keynes University Hospital</b>	<p><b>Date Range: 01/04/2014 and 31/03/2019</b></p> <p>Based on the information available in the data warehouse we are not able to provide the number of patients treated for sickle cell condition.</p> <p>However we have provided you the number of patients that were admitted to the hospital and had one of the diagnosis codes coded to the inpatient spell as sickle cell condition. We have also provided the number of admissions (one patient may be admitted more than once in the above time frame) with sickle cell condition during the above mentioned date range.</p> <p>This does not imply that the patients were treated for this condition.</p> <p>Also please note that patients with sickle cell condition can also be treated in an outpatient setting. Outpatient data available in the data warehouse does not contain patient diagnosis.
