Thank you for your request for information which we received on 28 September 2020.

I am pleased to confirm the following.

Specifically, when is the building work expected to begin and what is the timescale between starting building works, hiring staff for the centre, and treating patients? Have any of the plans for the radiotherapy centre been delayed or otherwise affected by the current pandemic?

I would also like to request information relating to the size of the department. How many linacs will the centre operate? Will there be a brachytherapy suite? How many staff (radiographers, clinicians, radiotherapy physicists, clinical technologists, clinical engineers) are expected to be hired to operate the centre?

There are no plans to build anything at the moment, with nothing agreed yet.
