Hearing Aids: Problem Solving (Earmoulds)

To check the hearing aid is working:





Turn the hearing aid on by closing the battery drawer

Note: some aids have a short delay before they work

2



Hold the aid between your hands


If the aid whistles it shows that the hearing aid is working

If the hearing aid does not whistle

check to see if the aid whistles after each of these steps

Change the battery

The new battery should be put in with the sticker facing upwards and then peeled off

Pull the mould off the hearing aid

Does the hearing aid whistle now?

If yes - then the tubing in the earmould is blocked



Check the end of the tubing is clear of wax

Check the tubing is not blocked with moisture

Hearing Aids: Problem Solving (Earmoulds)

Wash the mould with warm soapy water (this should be done once a week -see 'cleaning and retubing' leaflet)

6

Make sure that the mould is completely dry before putting it back on the hearing aid

7

If the tubing is very hard and discoloured then it needs changing

(this should be done every 6 months- see 'cleaning and retubing' leaflet)



* The hearing aid itself should only be wiped with a dry cloth, do not wash it and do not let it get wet!





If the hearing aid is still not whistling – then the hearing aid may be broken

- contact the Audiology Department for an appointment or bring the hearing aid in for the 'Drop off repair service' (see repair information leaflet)





When the hearing aid is in the ear correctly it should not whistle!
