MKUH will only request a DBS check on an individual/staff member if it is legally allowed to do so. The trigger for a check and the level of check (standard, enhanced etc) required is determined by the type of activity(ies) the individual in that role will be required to undertake and the level of access this will give them to patients. To determine the level of check, NHS Employers have created an online DBS eligibility tool (<https://www.nhsemployers.org/case-studies-and-resources/2018/08/dbs-eligibility-tool>) which asks a series of questions and helps identify whether an NHS position meets the criteria for a DBS check.
