



Request under Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your request for information which we received on 28 May 2021.

I am pleased to confirm the following.

- 1. The number of patients who were positive with Covid-19 who you discharged into care homes since you started recording patients suffering with coronavirus.
- 2. The number of patients who had recovered from Covid-19 who you discharged into care homes since you started recording patients suffering with coronavirus.
- 3. The care homes these patients were discharged into.
- 4. The dates that these discharges happened.

Although we record discharge location, to find out if the patient had COVID-19 and was discharged to a care home would entail manually checking each patient that has been discharged to a care home since March 2020 which would exceed the time limit under Section 12 and Personal Information under Section 40 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

You are advised that this information is provided in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and is for your personal use. Any re-use of this information will be subject to copyright and the Re-Use of Public Sector Information Regulations (1st July 05) and authorisation from Milton Keynes Hospital NHS Foundation Trust will be required.
