I am pleased to confirm the following.

Q1. How many patients were treated in the past 3 months for gastric and gastrooesophageal junction cancer (any stage) with:

- CAPOX (Capecitabine with Oxaliplatin) 1
- FOLFOX (Folinic acid, Fluorouracil and Oxaliplatin) 0
- Pembrolizumab in combination with Platinum (Cisplatin or Oxaliplatin) and Fluoropyrimidine (5-Fluorouracil or Capecitabine) 0
- Any other systemic anti-cancer therapy 0
- Palliative care only no access to conclusive data

Q2. How many patients were treated in the past 3 months for Oesophageal cancer (any stage) with:

- Pembrolizumab in combination with Platinum (Cisplatin or Oxaliplatin) and Fluoropyrimidene (5-Fluorouracil or Capecitabine) 0
- Platinum and Fluoropyrimidene based combination treatments (Cisplatin or Oxaliplatin with 5-Fluorouracil or Capecitabine) 7
- Nivolumab monotherapy 0
