I am pleased to confirm the following.

**Could you please tell me how many patients you have treated for Triple Negative breast cancer in the last 3 months with the following systemic anti-cancer therapies:**

- a) Anthracycline (eg doxorubicin) as single agent - 0
- b) Atezolizumab + nab-paclitaxel or paclitaxel - 2
- c) Capecitabine as a single agent - 0
- d) Eribulin as a single agent or in combination - 0
- e) PARP inhibitor (eg Olaparib) - 0
- f) Pembrolizumab + chemotherapy - 0
- g) Platinum (eg carboplatin, cisplatin) as a single agent - 0
- h) Taxane (eg docetaxel, paclitaxel, nab-paclitaxel) as a single agent - 0
- i) Taxane + Anthracycline based combinations - 1
- j) Vinorelbine as a single agent - 0
- k) Other active systemic anti-cancer therapy - 0
