Thank you for your request for information which we received on 17 February 2023.

I am pleased to confirm the following.

- First aid training
- Life support/CPR training
- Resuscitation/defibrillator training

First aid training is required where a local needs assessment indicates first aiders are required. Departmental managers are responsible for undertaking the needs assessment, determining the requirement re numbers and facilities then ensuring nominated staff are booked on to training which they must arrange and budget for. The training is via external provider, the trust advocating the use of St Johns Ambulance or the Red Cross. This is all written into our First Aid Policy.
