Who is our service for?



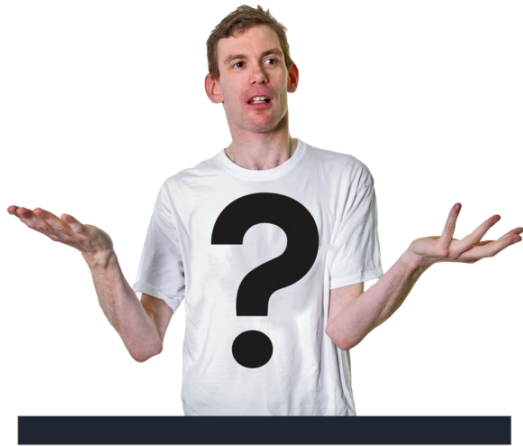
The Chaplaincy Team offer Pastoral, Spiritual and Religious Care to any patient, relative, or member of staff.

Holy Communion.



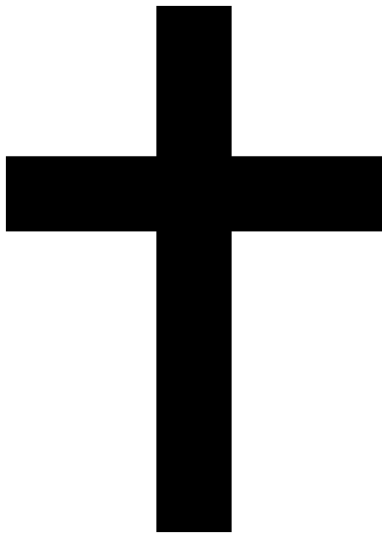

Chapel and Quiet Room



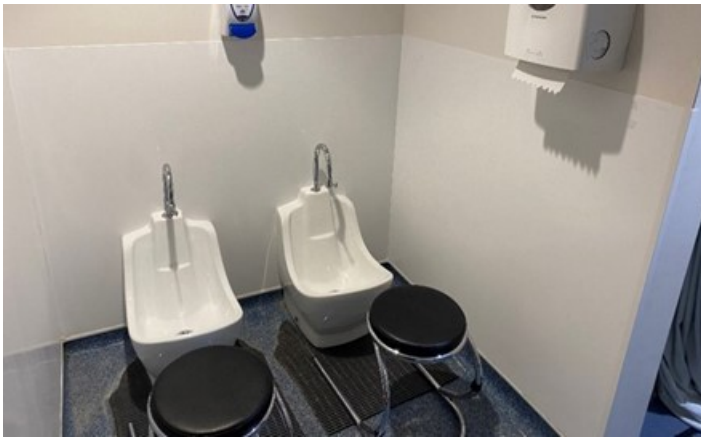
Anyone can come here at any time to pray or reflect.

Muslim Prayer Rooms



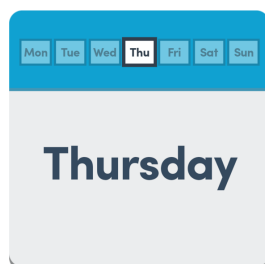
These have separate areas for men and women to wash and pray.

All our rooms are in **Blue Zone** on level 2, near Ward 21.

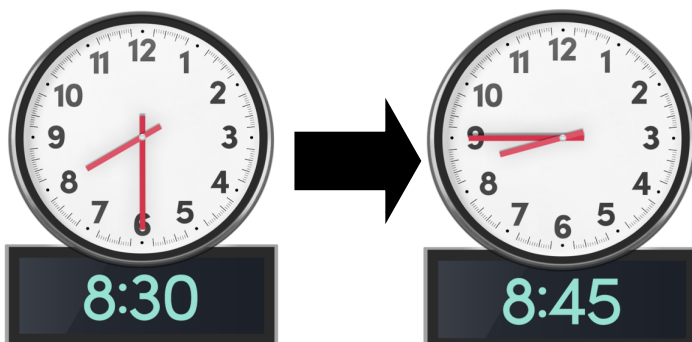
Religious Services

Thursday.

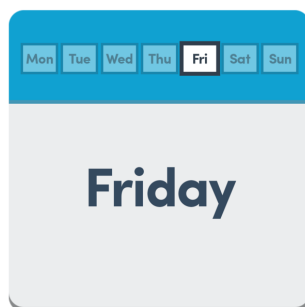


It is from 8.30am

every week.



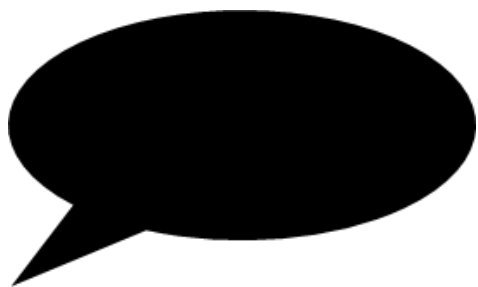
It is every Friday.

to 1.45pm.

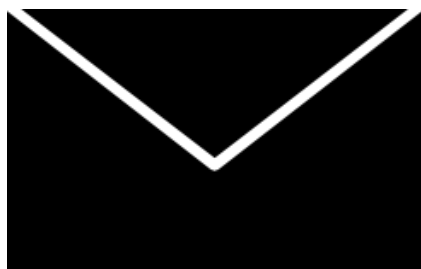
How to contact us
