Thank you for your request for information which we received on 16 February 2023.

I am pleased to confirm the following.

I have noticed that the following anti-diabetic products appear to have been removed from the formulary. Can you please advise if this is a permanent removal, or if they will be reinstated at some later date?

Dulaglutide (Trulicity®) Injection 0.75mg, 1.5mg

Exenatide (Byetta®) Injection 250mcg/mL

Liraglutide (Victoza®) 6mg/ml solution for injection, 3ml pre-filled pens (disposable injection)

Lixisenatide (Lyxumia®) Injection, 100 micrograms/mL (20 micrograms/dose) pre-filled pen

Semaglutide (Ozempic®) 0.25 mg solution for injection in pre-filled pen

Semaglutide (Ozempic®) 0.5 mg solution for injection in pre-filled pen

Semaglutide (Ozempic®) 1 mg solution for injection in pre-filled pen

Semaglutide (Rybelsus®) 3 mg, 7mg and 14mg tablets

The section had been taken down whilst it was updated but they are all showing on the formulary now.
