

**Request under Freedom of Information Act 2000**

Thank you for your request for information which we received on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> September 2023. I am pleased to confirm the following.

**Can I request the number of patient safety incidents that resulted in a severe or death degree of harm to the patients (as defined by NHS England [here](#)) and what month and year they took place from 2010 to present please.**

**Can I also have these as two separate figures - one for severe and one for death - and a figure of how many deaths there were in total as an incident can refer to more than one death.**

We cannot extrapolate deaths where there was a harm event that may have contributed to that death and deaths which have been reported as incidents but there was no harm event.

We would have to go through every death to gain this information.
