Thank you for your request for information which we received on Monday 12th February 2024. I am pleased to confirm the following

Q1. How many patients have been treated for breast cancer (any stage) in the past 3 months with the following systemic anti-cancer therapies:

- Abemaciclib + Aromatase Inhibitor (e.g. anastrozole, exemestane, letrozole)- 16
- Abemaciclib + Fulvestrant-6
- Alpelisib + Fulvestrant- 4
- Anthracycline (e.g. doxorubicin or epirubicin) as a single agent-0
- Atezolizumab +Nab-paclitaxel/Paclitaxel-0
- Capecitabine as a single agent- 25
- Eribulin as a single agent or in combination-1
- Everolimus + Exemestane-0
- Fulvestrant as a single agent-0
- Lapatinib-0
- Neratinib-1
- Parp Inhibitors (Olaparib/Talazoparib)-1
- Palbociclib + Aromatase Inhibitor (e.g. anastrozole, exemestane, letrozole)-9
- Palbociclib + Fulvestrant-0
- Pembrolizumab-0
- Platinum (e.g. carboplatin or cisplatin) as a single agent-0
- Ribociclib + Aromatase Inhibitor (e.g. anastrozole, exemestane, letrozole)-35
- Ribociclib + Fulvestrant- 7
- Sacituzumab Govitecan-0
- Taxane (e.g. docetaxel, paclitaxel, nab-paclitaxel) as a single agent -6
- Taxane and/or Anthracycline in combination-63
- Trastuzumab as a single agent or in combination-60
- Trastuzumab emtansine-5
- Transtuzumab deruxtecan-3
- Any other active systemic anti-cancer therapy- Carboplatin Gemcitabine -1 , Paclitaxel Albumin Bound -1 , vinorelbine -2
