

**Request under Freedom of Information Act 2000**

Thank you for your request for information which we received on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2024. I am pleased to confirm the following.

**A. How many patients have been treated with the following drugs in the past 4 months:**

- Atogepant (Aquipta) – any disease 0 patients
- Erenumab (Aimovig) - any disease 27 patients
- Eptinezumab (Vypti) – any disease 0 patients
- Fremanezumab (Ajovy) - any disease 4 patients
- Galcanezumab (Emgality) - any disease 0 patients
- Rimegepant (Vyndura) – any disease 0 patients
- Botulinum Toxin (i.e., Botox, Dysport, Xeomin) - migraine ONLY

We are unable to identify this information as we do not store indication for usage for this drug.

**B. How many patients have you treated in the last 4 months for chronic migraine (15+ headache days per month) and episodic migraine (4-15 headache days per month) with the following drugs:**
