Request under Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your request for information which we received on Monday 31 March 2025. I am pleased to confirm the following.

Of all the patients presenting at your largest A&E department with mental ill health (psychiatric, psychological, and/or behavioural disturbances/changes), how many were assessed by a mental health practitioner within one hour of being referred to mental health services? Please provide year by year data between and including 2019 to 2025 and include data up to the end of February 2025.

MKUH currently only tracks response times for a small proportion of psychiatric referrals. As a result, any data reflecting percentages of cases seen within one hour would not accurately represent our overall performance.

Consequently, we are unable to provide a precise response to this Freedom of Information request.
