Request under Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your request for information which we received on Monday 24 March 2025. I am pleased to confirm the following.

I would like to see all emails, documents, attachments, and any other forms of response relating to this request between Milton Keynes University Hospital NHS Foundation Trust and the two senior NHS officials.

Please see attached document.

It is public information that you have been asked to inform the NHS when you "envisage adopting already available nationally commissioned local Products".

I would like to know when specifically, you plan to start adopting the FDP and who you are naming as lead (as is requested in the letter)?

We have started work to deploy the inpatient module but are phasing the full implementation in line with a larger upgrade to our outpatient and RTT workflows. We will therefore deploy limited inpatient functionality during April/ May 2025 and anticipate having all three modules fully deployed by the end of Q4 25/26.

I would also like to know what your plans are for how you will maximise the benefits of the Federated Data Platform to deliver better joined-up care for their patients within the next two years (again, asked of you in the above mentioned letter)?

Through the programme governance we will work to monitor benefits realisation in line with those set out in the FDP programme and other internal business cases.

We have identified an internal programme manager who is leading on staff training and system adoption. The Executive COO for planned care has overall accountability for the delivery of the programme benefits.

As a teaching hospital, we conduct education and research to improve healthcare for our patients. During your visit students may be involved in your care, or you may be asked to participate in a clinical trial. Please speak to your doctor or nurse if you have any concerns.
