Request under Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your request for information which we received on Thursday 1 May 2025. I am pleased to confirm the following.

1. The number of pregnant patients who identified as transgender (i.e. trans men, non-binary, gender diverse) who received care for labour and delivery with the obstetrics and gynaecology department at each hospital under your trust. Please provide this information broken down for each hospital, and the numbers from over the last three years, from January to December in 2022, 2023, and 2024.

Please provide this information in an Excel format.

Unfortunately, we are unable to provide data on this, we are unable to identify from E-care any service users that meet the criteria and therefore we cannot track whether there have been any complaints made.

2. Any complaints received by each hospital under your trust, from a pregnant, transgender patient who received treatment from the obstetrics and gynaecology department, from the last three years (Jan-December 2022, 2023, and 2024).

Please disclose the nature and content of these complaints and provide them in a Word document format.
